Donation days

Before the fair we have donation days, where we ask children to bring in to school goods for the fair and in return they get a token to spend at the fair, there are 3 donation days so they can earn 3 tokens. Donations can be made between 8 and 9am and only donations made at this time will attract a token. Donations can be left in reception otherwise.

Class	Teacher	Stall
Starfish	Miss K Buckland	Soft Toy Tombola - £1 a go every one a winner, relies on donations and people willing to wash toys
Jellyfish	Miss G Yates	Envelope Game , buy an envelope and find out if there is a prize in it
Stingray	Mrs M Bartley	Books and Toys – relies on donations, normally runs as a tombola for the best quality toys and a toy sale for the rest
3L	Mrs E London	Chocolate Tombola – relies on donations, always sells out quickly!
3M	Mrs McGrath	Kids Crafts – interesting crafts for children to do and take home their artwork
3R	Miss S Ramstead	Jam Jar Tombola – relies on donations of decorated jam jars containing sweets, trinkets, toys or money etc
4G	Miss Spalding	Grotto ticket sales Token sales - for use on the year 6 stalls – small stalls where the children can play games and win prizes. Tokens are worth 40p and can be used as cash on any stall at the fair
4M	Miss R Misson	Adult Gifts to 3:00pm ish – the children can buy a present for mum or dad After adult gifts are sold out - Movie room & card colouring – to keep smaller children occupied
4J	Miss J Smith	Bottle Tombola – Adults only, a traditional favourite
5B	Miss K Beugelaar	Cake Stall – relies on donations, plates are sent out during the week of the fair
5M	Miss L Morley	Trash and Treasure – needs helpers to make up small boxes and donations of small prizes
5W	Mrs Welch	Lucky Dip - £1 a go every go a winner, wrapped prizes
6C	Miss S Carver	Refreshments Year 6 Stalls (all run by year 6 students) Games and nails, tattoos, face painting etc, very popular with the children
6F	Mr N Harverson	Refreshments Year 6 Stalls (all run by year 6 students) Games and nails, tattoos, face painting etc, very popular with the children
